3. Interview/ Viva-Voce-

- In the Interview Test, the **minimum qualifying marks** would be 25% for the General category candidates and 20% for Schedules Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Economically Backward Caste & Backwards Caste.
- No candidate, irrespective of his marks in the Mains Examination, shall be eligible for selection for appointment if he obtains less than the minimum prescribed marks in the Interview Test.
- The **final selection list** shall be prepared on the basis of the marks obtained in the Main Examination and the Interview both.
